

FAMILY ST. PATRICK'S DAY SCAVENGER HUNT

St. Patrick's Day fun doesn't have to be complicated! Follow the steps below to create a scavenger hunt for the kids, and finish it off with a special St. Patrick's Day treat!



Use colorful sticky notes to lay out a path to different rooms around the house—and even out in the yard if the weather is nice.



Have a starting point where you can introduce kids to the idea of the scavenger hunt and put on some fun green merch (mardi gras beads, hats, sunglasses—whatever you can find).



Create seven—lucky—stations, each with a note teaching about the history of St. Patrick's Day and a chocolate gold coin. Read the historical notes and learn together, and gather the gold coins to put in the pot—or bowl—of gold at the end of the rainbow path.



When your family has gathered all seven coins, follow the path back to the kitchen, where you get to make shamrock shakes together! It's as easy as throwing mint chip ice cream and milk in the blender (and add a little food coloring if you want to up the green levels).
