

The Parent Portal Shortcut



A step-by-step guide to adding the Parent Portal to your phone's home screen.

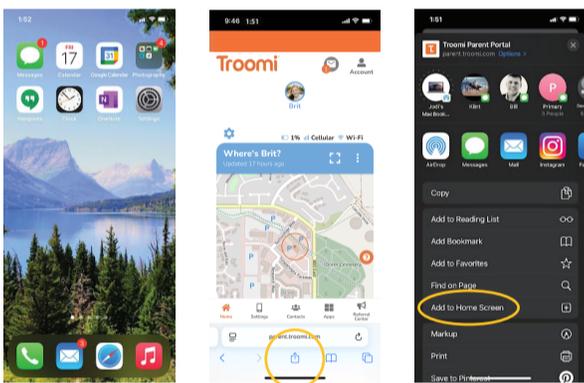
While we don't have an app for the Parent Portal quite yet, we have a simple solution that'll make managing your child's phone functionality **easy peasy lemon squeezy!**

Instead of opening up an internet browser, searching for our website, and so on and so forth, every single time, you can create an app-like icon (or shortcut) and stick it to your home screen. Our expectation is you'll still have to enter your credentials, but the Parent Portal will immediately be at your fingertips. Cool, huh?

iPhone

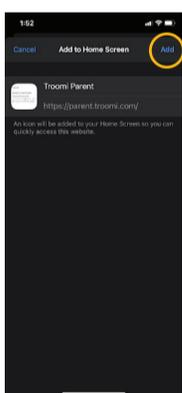
STEP 01

Open the Safari app and access parent.troomi.com. Tap the "share" icon in the middle of the task bar at the bottom of the screen, scroll down, then select the "Add to Home Screen" option.



STEP 02

If you'd like, you can change the name of the icon. After you've picked the perfect nickname, tap "Add" on the upper right corner of the screen.



STEP 03

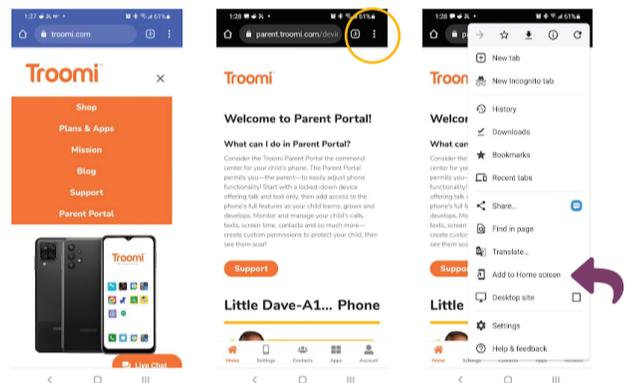
The icon is complete! Tap the icon to be taken to the Troomi Parent Portal. To move the icon elsewhere on your screen, press and hold the icon and tap "Edit Home Screen". Voila!



Android

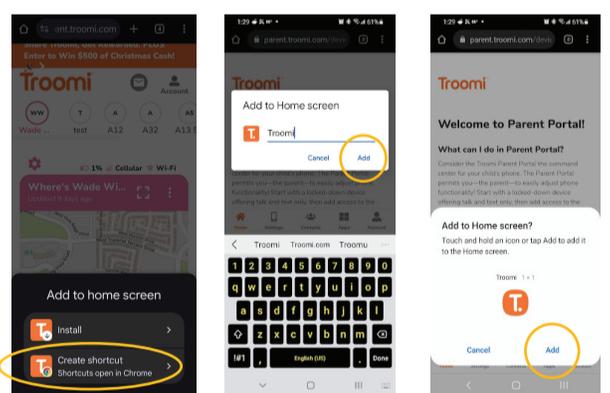
STEP 01

Open the Chrome app and access parent.troomi.com. Tap the "menu" icon—or three dots—in the upper right corner of the screen, then select the "Add to Home screen" option.



STEP 02

If you'd like, you can change the name of the icon. After you've picked the perfect nickname, tap "Add automatically" to add the icon to any available space on your home screen, or press and hold the icon to move it elsewhere.



STEP 03

The icon is complete. Tap the icon to be taken directly to your parent portal.
